Biographical Note: (Who was/is this person?) James Easton Brodhead (1932-2012) was a character actor who worked in various motion picture, television, and theatre productions. From 1950-1963, Brodhead appeared in numerous stage and live television productions. In 1963, Brodhead changed careers and became a journalist with "Time" magazine from 1963-1969, covering various stories including the assassination of Robert Kennedy and the ensuing trial of Sirhan Sirhan. He then left "Time" to write a book on "Rowan and Martin's Laugh-In," and worked as a public relations account executive for a short time. In 1971, he returned to acting full-time, appearing in "The Apple Dumpling Gang," "The Strongest Man in the World," "Kotch," "Mame," and "General Hospital," among many other motion picture, television, and theatre productions.

Scope & Content Note: (What is this accretion about?) Contains personal and professional files relating to James E. Brodhead's travels, written works, and legal cases. Includes letter correspondence, mementos from his travels, such as brochures and post cards, case files relating to the Globe Newspaper Company and Brodhead v. Los Angeles Unifield School District, and newspaper clippings.
