Struthers Burt (1882-1954) and his wife, Katharine Newlin Burt (b.1882) were Wyoming homesteaders in Jackson Hole, Wyoming. They were also authors of national repute. Struthers Burt wrote books on his experiences in Wyoming, short stories, and poetry. Katharine Newlin Burt wrote novels, short stories, plays and poetry.

This collection focuses mainly on the writings of Katharine Newlin Burt. It includes correspondence (1919-1970); legal documents (1911-970), covering foreign rights to her books, motion picture agreements, and the theatrical adaptation of SILVER APPLES; financial records; her diary for the year 1936; manuscripts of her novels, short stories, and poetry; and, scripts of plays. Two manuscripts of Struthers Burt are part of the collection. Printed material is included in the collection, together with Katharine Newlin Burt's notebooks.
